



Costs not included in Tuition (Grades K-8)

1) Uniforms

Uniforms must be ordered through *Lands' End* and our Preferred School Number is 900163437. Boys have two choices in (Skylark-embroidered) shirts, cobalt blue and red polos. Girls have light blue and red polos. A red polo is required for Wednesday chapels. Navy pants and shorts are options for boys and girls. In addition, girls may also wear a plaid jumper or navy skirt. Skylark-embroidered navy sweaters available on Land's End are optional. The choices should be automatically limited to the appropriate ones once you enter the school number on the Land's End website. Students must wear black or brown shoes of almost any type such as Merrills, Chacos, Keens, tennis shoes, or dress shoes. Boots are not to be worn in class. Finally, socks are limited to black or navy blue.

2) Conditioning Clothes (5th-8th Graders)

All students must wear a Skylark light blue t-shirt we have available in the office for \$14 with all black sweatpants (for girls: no yoga or stretch pants). Additionally, in warm weather, students may wear all black athletic shorts and tennis shoes.

3) Hooded Skylark Sweatshirts

We have hooded sweatshirts students can wear in class for \$20. They are also available in the office. Students may not wear coats in class.

4) Conditioning Equipment Requirements (5th-8th Grades)

Each year we will select two or three conditioning life skills in which the students will participate. Possibilities include, but are not limited to, golfing, swimming, biking, archery, snowshoeing, hiking and classes at the GWS Rec Center. The goals of conditioning are for students to learn a life-long skill, experience being in new places in our community, and exercise. Parents are expected to provide necessary equipment (snowshoes, hiking shoes, a bicycle, a swimsuit, etc.) With advance warning, parents and staff may work together to find equipment if this requirement causes hardship. Rentals, purchasing and borrowing are all options.

5) Application and Assessment fees (New Students Only)

Upon receipt of the application, \$100 per student (\$50 for the assessment and \$50 for the application) is due.

6) Van (Down valley students only)

We offer bus service from New Castle's City Market parking lot on a first come, first serve basis until we have 14 riders. Then the service will be closed until a new, permanent spot opens; and parents may place their child(ren) on a wait list. Please contact the school for pricing and availability.
